<p style="text-align: center;">Creative Europe, “Organisation and implementation of a biennial European Union Prize for contemporary architecture ” - EAC/S06/2017</p> <p>The purpose of this call for proposals is to support an organisation/consortium in organising the European Union Prize for contemporary architecture for the European Commission for the period 2018-2021 (editions 2019 and 2021 of the Prize). The action would entail the development of selection procedures for the Prize winners, the organisation of award ceremonies and side events as well as the promotion of the Prizes and their winners via communication activities at local, national, European and international levels.</p> <p>Eligible applicants: Legal persons that have had a legal personality for at least 2 years on the date of the deadline for submission of applications.</p>	<p>18/08/2017</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Preparatory Actions on Communications Networks, Content and Technology, “Open Knowledge Technologies: Mapping and Validating Knowledge” - PAOKT-2017-AG</p> <p>The overall objective of this preparatory action is to develop and demonstrate a Europe wide learning and assessment technology. The proposed solution should integrate and improve the development of non-cognitive skills by testing and piloting them for effectiveness in various learning and training contexts. The action is expected to develop a European-wide learning technology system to support, enhance and facilitate the learning of non-cognitive skills of European citizens at risk of exclusion, in particular unemployed youth. The project should include a thoughtful and comprehensive social innovation process to engage citizens at risk of exclusion in Europe. The different services will need to be tested, including by users, and demonstrated.</p> <p>Eligible applicants: Only applications from legal entities established in the EU Member States are eligible. Applications may be submitted by a single legal entity or by a consortium made up of several legal entities or by one applicant, whether established specifically or not for the action.</p>	<p>05/09/2017</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Preparatory Action, “Subtitling European cultural TV content across Europe” - CNECT 2017/3110435</p> <p>The aim of this preparatory action is to support innovative strategies for the provision of subtitled versions of European factual cultural programming to facilitate cross border on-line dissemination of cultural content. The objective is to test the added value of subtitling on the on-line circulation and outreach of European cultural programming in the European Union. Concretely, the preparatory action should support the provision of a minimum of 300 hours of diverse European factual subtitled cultural content online in a number of European territories via 1-3 projects; and to assess the impact of this provision. The results of the undertaken actions should be shared with stakeholders and policy makers, notably through the organisation of a public workshop.</p> <p>Eligible applicants: Only applications from legal entities established in the EU Member States are eligible. The proposal must be submitted by an applicant or a group of applicants (consortium) providing non-linear audiovisual media services within the meaning of the AVMS Directive 2010/13/EU, with a critical mass of audiovisual content. The service should provide European factual content and contain a strong cultural added value. Services focusing on cinema or TV fiction and animation are ineligible as is light entertainment, sport news and current affairs. The services should have been available for a minimum of two years. The service should have a significant audience in the country of origin and be already available in territories to be targeted by the new linguistic offer (a baseline audience to be defined by the applicant).</p>	<p>15/09/2017</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Preparatory Action, “Crowdsourcing subtitling to increase the circulation of European works” - CNECT 2017/3135124</p> <p>The aim of this preparatory action is to test the impact of any innovative solution to decrease the costs of subtitling and increase the circulation of European films by making more efficient use of public funding on subtitling and dubbing. The objective of this action is to increase the availability, the exploitation and the circulation of European works. The call will focus on two priorities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Find innovative solutions for high-quality film translation. • Enable tracking of language versions and enable service providers (e.g. VOD services, catch-up TV services or cinemas) to easily find the language version of their choice. <p>Eligible applicants: Only applications from legal entities established in the EU Member States are eligible.</p>	<p>15/09/2017</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Rights, Equality and Citizenship Programme (REC), “Prevent and combat gender-based violence and violence against children” – REC-RDAP-GBV-AG-2017</p> <p>The aim of this call is to prevent and combat all forms of violence against children, young people and women, as well as violence against other groups at risk, in particular groups at risk of violence in close relationships, and to protect victims of such violence. The call will focus on the following priorities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prevention of gender-based violence (GBV); • Protection and support for victims of gender-based violence and violence against children; • The coordination and/or adaptation of support services for sexual and gender-based violence to include refugees and migrants (children, women, LGBTQI persons, young men and boys); <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Treatment of perpetrators; • National coordinating frameworks or action plans for violence against children (supporting Member States and other actors). <p>Eligible applicants: The applicants must be public entities or private organisations, duly established in one of the countries participating in the Programme, or international organisations. Organisations which are profit-oriented must submit applications in partnership with public entities or private non-profit organisations. The project can be either national or transnational.
